Body Hd2 Ind 1 is used to indent text following a Bullet 1 Hd 2 (if the text continues the same thought as the bullet, but requires a separate paragraph.)

- n Bullet 2 Hd 2 is used for the second level of bullets under Bullet 1 Hd2

Body Hd 2 Ind 2 is used to indent text following a Bullet 2 Hd 2 (if the text continues the same thought as the bullet, but requires a separate paragraph.)

Body Hd 3 is used after Heading 3 in chapters (and Heading 8 in appendices)

- p Bullet 1 Hd 3 is used for the first level of bullets after Body Hd 3 following Heading 3 in chapters (and Heading 8 in appendices)

Body Hd 3 Ind 1 is used to indent text following a Bullet 1 Hd 3 (if the text continues the same thought as the bullet, but requires a separate paragraph.)

- n Bullet 2 Hd 3 is used for the second level of bullets under Bullet 1 Hd 3

Body Hd 3 Ind 2 is used to indent text following a Bullet 2 Hd 3 (if the text continues the same thought as the bullet, but requires a separate paragraph.)

Body Hd 4 is used after Heading 4 in chapters (and Heading 9 in appendices).

- p Bullet 1 Hd 4 is used for the first level of bullets after Body Hd 4

Body Hd 4 Ind 1 is used to indent text following a Bullet 1 Hd 4 (if the text continues the same thought as the bullet, but requires a separate paragraph.)

- n Bullet 2 Hd 4 is used for the second level of bullets under Bullet 1 Hd 4

Body Hd 4 Ind 2 is used to indent text following a Bullet 2 Hd 4 (if the text continues the same thought as the bullet, but requires a separate paragraph.)

Body Hd 5 is used after Heading 5 in chapters (There is no equivalent for appendices.)

- p Bullet 1 Hd 5 is used for the first level of bullets after Body Hd 5 (There is no equivalent for appendices.)

Body Hd 5 Ind 1 is used to indent text following a Bulled 1 Hd 4 (if the text continues the same thought as the bullet, but requires a separate paragraph.)

- n Bullet 2 Hd 5 is used for the second level of bullets under Bullet 1 Hd 4

Body Hd 5 Ind 2 is used to indent text following a Bullet 2 Hd 5 (if the text continues the same thought as the bullet, but requires a separate paragraph)

Body Italic is character formatting. It is used for the title of documents and for emphasis.

Body Hd2 Ind 1 is used to indent text following a Bullet 1 Hd 2 (if the text continues the same thought as the bullet, but requires a separate paragraph.)

n Bullet 2 Hd 2 is used for the second level of bullets under Bullet 1 Hd2

A.1.1. Heading 8 – Use this as a Heading 3 for appendices

Body Hd 3 Ind 1 is used to indent text following a Bullet 1 Hd 3 (if the text continues the same thought as the bullet, but requires a separate paragraph.)
